Good morning. For the record, I am Senator Rebecca Perkins Kwoka from Senate District 21, representing the city of Portsmouth and the towns of Madbury, Lee, Durham, Newington, Newmarket, and Newfields. I am the Prime Sponsor of SB 278-FN, an act relative to funding for the Piscataqua River turning basin project in the port authority project.

SB 278 is a request from Geno Marconi, Port Director of the NH Port Authority. In the 2019 budget package, a sum of money was assigned to a Port Authority project in the Rye Harbor. Those funds were refunded by the contractor and SB 278 will allow those funds to be made available to the Piscataqua River Turning Basin widening project. The Piscataqua River Turning Basin has been an issue for years, with the size of the turning basin no longer being sufficient for modern vessels. Widening the turning basin with these additional funds will be a massive boon to the Seacoast economically, making the area more efficient and much safer. In the 2021 budget package, \$1,500,000 was appropriated to the turning basin project; SB 278 is taking the remaining \$251,143 from the 2019 Rye Harbor project and adding to the total for the turning basin project.

Although the language of the bill is not clear in this respect at first glance, this bill is not drawing new funds but, instead, reallocating funds from the 2019 budget cycle that were reabsorbed by the General Fund because no "nonlapsing" language was used at that time.

The Senate Finance Committee amended SB 278 to be more correct in its form and make it more in-line with other appropriations bills. SB 278-FN passed the Senate Finance Committee 6-0 and passed the full Senate on a voice vote.

### STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Two

AN ACT relative to funding for the Piscataqua River turning basin project in the port authority project.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Piscataqua River Turning Basin; Appropriation. Amend 2021, 107:14, II to read as follows:
  2 II. The sum of [\$1,500,000] \$1,751,143 is hereby appropriated for the biennium ending June
  3 30, 2023 to the Pease development authority for the Piscataqua River Turning Basin. Of the
  4 amount appropriated, \$251,143 shall be a charge against the United States Army Corps of
  5 Engineering refund back to the state for the Rye Harbor Dredging Project per 2019, 146:1,
  6 XIII, B.
- 7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
