Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

New Paragraph; Municipal Budget Law; Budget Committees. Amend RSA 32:17 by inserting
after paragraph II the following new paragraph:

3 II-a. The budget committee may require a governing body to provide its budget 4 recommendations in full line item detail in active spreadsheet format to the members of the budget 5 committee.

6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

Summary of testimony presented in support:

Representative Joe Alexander

- HB 1026 clarifies that a budget committee may require that the governing body provide budget recommendations in full line item detail in active spreadsheet format.
- Currently in the RSA it states that the budget committee is allowed to request the information in any form they wish.
- He believes this is just clarifying language.
- In his personal experience sometimes the budget committee will make requests but the governing body wants to provide it in a different format.
- This will just confirm that the budget committee has the ability to request the information this way.
- Senator Perkins Kwoka asked if he could clarify what the word "active" means referring to the spreadsheet.
 - o Rep. Alexander replied that he believes it means that you can make edits to it.
- Senator Gray commented that one year ago they revised the statutes regarding budget committees and receiving information in spreadsheet format. He asked why those changes are not working and why change it again before the first changes have gone through a couple of budget cycles.
 - Rep. Alexander replied that last year's revisions are happening and are working very well. This is for members of the committee should they want to access the spreadsheet themselves in computer format during the meeting.
