HOUSE BILL **1037**

AN ACT relative to the governor's duties during a state of emergency.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Homeland Security; Governor Duty. Amend RSA 21-P:43-a to read as follows:
- 2 21-P:43-a Governor Duty. The governor shall provide a list of all expenditures pursuant to this
- 3 subdivision under a state of emergency to the executive council [~~for informational purposes only~~]
- 4 within 30 days of the expenditure, in order to ensure transparency.
- 5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
