STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to certain committees and commissions of the department of state.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1       1 Department of State; Commissions and Boards Functioning Within Department; Removals.

2 Amend RSA 5:13 to read as follows:

3       5:13 Commissions and Boards Functioning Within Department. The ballot law commission[  
4 ~~the boxing and wrestling commission and the joint board of licensure and certification~~] shall [each]  
5 function within the department of state as a separate organizational entity and with all the powers  
6 and duties as heretofore provided, except as otherwise provided by law.

7       2 Boxing and Wrestling Commission; Attachment Removed. Amend RSA 285:2 to read as  
8 follows:

9       285:2 Establishment of Commission. There is hereby established a boxing and wrestling  
10 commission which shall oversee amateur and professional fighting sports in the state. [The  
11 ~~commission shall be administratively attached to the department of state pursuant to RSA 21-G:10.~~]

12       3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
