Summary of testimony presented in support:

Rep. Graham

- This bill is very simply housekeeping.
- During the last capital budget there was an appropriation for a joint hangar project between state police and the army national guard.
- After the capital budget was passed, the DOD changed the criteria for building an army hangar but did not give any more money to cover the additional cost.
- He was approached to address the funding situation.
- The bill leaves the federal money for the national guard hangar separate. It separates out the generally funded portion for state police, which needs to continue forward. It also provides more transparency on who is doing what.
- The rest of the bill is housekeeping to show where the money is accounted for and lapses.
