Summary of testimony presented:

Senator Watters, Senate District 4

- SB 1230-FN aims to change the procedures for registering deer. In addition to deer being taken to a registration station, it adds the option of an online process established by the executive director of Fish and Game. Lines 10-16 of the bill describe the online registration process. The last section beginning on line 17 gives the executive director the power through administrative rule to suspend or limit online registration in the event of a wildlife or public health emergency or for days designated for biological sample collection.

Representative Lang, Belknap-District 4.

- Representative Lang is the Chairman of the House Fish and Game Committee. He stated that the bill was voted unanimously out of committee and was passed on the consent calendar.
- The amendment for the bill did two things, Firstly, it extended the date in order to give Fish and Game enough time to implement the bill. Secondly, the amendment gave some exemptions for Fish and Game to suspend the online registration process in situations where public or wildlife health is at risk or when biological sampling is required.
- Senator Watters asked what the cost to the department will be. Representative Lang stated that there has been talk about the costs for the department. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the department implemented online registration for turkey which was successful. They do not have an exact figure for the costs.
- Senator Watters asked if there has been any concern that folks may present a deer online that they did not kill. Representative Lang stated that they heard no concern on that matter from the public or the department.

Dan Bergeron, Department of Fish and Game

- Current RSA's do not allow for online deer registration. All registrations for deer must be done in person. They have been heading in the direction for online registrations. They first implemented online registration for turkey partly due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This was possible because of the wording of the RSA's concerning turkey.
- Typically, people go to businesses like sporting goods stores or convenient stores in order to register their deer. Lately, they have been having trouble finding more places to register deer. There is currently a 2 dollar fee for registration and some of these businesses believe it is not worth their time. Overall, this has made it difficult for hunters to find registration stations in time. SB 1230-FN will give the hunters another option.
- The department is satisfied with the amendment to the bill. It is very important for the department to be able to collect biological information. They staff 18 biologists at higher traffic registration stations throughout the hunting season. They collect antler measurements, body weights, as well as information on female deer so that they may track and manage the health of the herd. They will take other biological information such as blood samples to investigate mosquito-borne illnesses and SARS COVID-2 in deer.
- Senator Watters asked if the department believes they will be able to let people know quickly about health risks, especially the possibility of a new COVID variant in the animal population. Mr. Bergeron stated that they have been able to contact hunters directly in the past through social media, press releases, and by email. As the online systems come into use, they will have better communication methods. The bill is a step in the right direction.

- Senator Gray asked if there are any other animals that should be allowed to be registered online besides deer. Mr. Bergeron stated that at the moment, deer and turkey is sufficient since they are the most popular.

Testimony in support of HB 1230-FN, an act permitting online presentation of deer for registration.

Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee

March 22, 2022

Mr. Chairman and members of the Committee, thank you for the opportunity to speak with you today. My name is Dan Bergeron. I am the Chief of the Wildlife Division for the Fish and Game Department. I'm here today representing the Department and the Fish and Game Commission in Support of HB 1230-FN, an act permitting online presentation of deer for registration.

The Department relies on data collected through mandatory registration of harvested deer to effectively manage the state's deer herd. Historically this data has been collected at physical deer registration stations. These stations are typically operated out of local businesses such as sporting goods shops, convenience stores, and hardware stores. In the past few years however, it has become more difficult for the Department to find businesses who are interested in registering deer and the number of stations across the state has declined. As a result it has become more difficult for hunters to find a convenient, open station to register their deer in a timely manner.

Moving forward, the Department would like the ability to allow hunters to register their deer themselves online to provide a more convenient option. Current language in RSA 208:15 does not allow the Department to institute an online deer registration system. Therefore we are supportive of this bill as it would provide that authority. The Department also needs the flexibility to require hunters to register deer in person at a physical registration station at certain times throughout the season. Mandatory in-person registration allows the Department to collect necessary, detailed biological information to help track the health of the state's deer population. Currently, Biologists are staffed at our highest volume stations, during the busiest days of the season and collect information on ages, weights, antler measurements, productivity measurements, and various other biological samples. This past year for example the Department partnered with NH Health and Human Services and USDA APHIS to collect blood samples from deer to screen for various mosquito borne diseases and SARS-CoV-2 antibodies in deer. The ability to require hunters to register deer in person allows us to obtain an adequate and unbiased sample of harvested animals. This bill as written would provide the Department that ability.

I would like to thank the Committee for allowing me to testify before you today and respectfully request the Committee members vote in Support of HB 1230-FN.
