Summary of testimony presented in support:

Senator French

- This bill eliminates the need for an auctioneer to carry a \$25K bond.
- Senator French has been a licensed auctioneer since he was 18 and the industry
 has changed dramatically after the internet. Prior to the internet, all auctions
 were conducted live by licensed auctioneers. Now less than 5% of auctions are
 live.
- The state does not require licensed for online auction sales.
- To his knowledge, there has never been an instance where the performance bond has been used to settle a dispute.
