AN ACT relative to the bond required of applicants for auctioneer licenses.

ANALYSIS

This bill repeals the requirement that applicants for licensure as an auctioneer file bond with the secretary of state.

AN ACT relative to the bond required of applicants for auctioneer licenses.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Repeal; Auctioneers; Bond. The following are repealed:

2 I. RSA 311-B:5, IV, relative to the requirement to file bond with an auctioneer license
3 application.

4 II. RSA 311-B:8, relative to the bond required of auctioneer license applicants.

5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

Summary of testimony presented in support:

Senator French

- This bill eliminates the need for an auctioneer to carry a \$25K bond.
- Senator French has been a licensed auctioneer since he was 18 and the industry has changed dramatically after the internet. Prior to the internet, all auctions were conducted live by licensed auctioneers. Now less than 5% of auctions are live.
- The state does not require licensed for online auction sales.
- To his knowledge, there has never been an instance where the performance bond has been used to settle a dispute.
