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ANALYSIS

This bill revises the circumstances under which certain persons are disqualified from performing certain duties of an election official.

Any person, other than a moderator, clerk, 3 658:24 selectman, inspector of election, or supervisor of the checklist, whose name appears on a ballot for an 4 elective position, other than a position of an election official, shall be disqualified from performing 5 duties as an election official in that election. Any election official, other than the moderator, who is also 12a candidate for office, other than a position of an election official, shall not be allowed to remain 13in the area designated for the handling of marked ballots and for the counting of votes 14within the guardrail during the counting of votes for an office for which he is a candidate. Such 15official shall disqualify himself from election duties relating to the tabulation of votes; and the · 16 moderator shall appoint an assistant who shall take the same oath as, serve in the same capacity as, 17and have all the powers of the election official who is disqualified until such official may properly 18 The moderator may assign any election official disqualified pursuant to this 19 return. section to other duties not related to the tabulation of votes. 20

Summary of testimony presented in support:

Senator James Gray

- This is legislation that was part of an omnibus bill that passed the Senate last year.
- RSA 658:24 and RSA 659:58 have some conflicting language and this bill clears that up.
- The language was approved by the Secretary of State's office.
- Communities are having a hard time finding enough people to work on election day and this allows those that are on the ballot to work.
- • Senator Soucy asked him to identify the sections that were in conflict.
 - Senator Gray responded that on line 9 they added the language "pursuant to RSA 659:58" and then on lines 13, 14,19 and 20 language was added to clarify what is allowed. Those modifications reference each other and creates language that is no longer in conflict.
- Senator Soucy asked if this includes all offices as well as the Moderator.
 - Senator Gray stated that yes, it includes all election officials and the Moderator.

Christina Guilford

- She has always found this to be a big conflict within the statutes.
- She is glad that it is getting clarified because larger towns like hers have the same problem on election day as the smaller towns do.
- Senator Gray commented that there are some communities that are small enough, that if they do not have this clarification, they cannot hold the election.
