### **ANALYSIS**

This bill makes adjustments to the board of dental examiners, primarily regarding the use of anesthesia and sedation by dentists and dental facilities.

The bill is a request of the board of dental examiners.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 Dentists and Dentistry; Board Appointment; Term; Compensation. Amend RSA 317-A:2, I to

- I. There shall be a board of dental examiners consisting of 9 members; including 6 dentists, 2 dental hygienists, and one public member, each to be appointed by the governor, with the approval of the council, to a term of 5 years. One dentist member shall have a current permit to administer general anesthesia and deep sedation. No member of the board shall be appointed to more than 2 consecutive terms. Only board members provided for in this paragraph shall have the authority to vote in board determinations.
  - 2 New Section; Dentists and Dentistry; Examining Board. Amend RSA 317-A by inserting after section 2-a the following new section:
- 11 317-A:2-b Anesthesia and Sedation Committee.
  - I.(a) An anesthesia and sedation committee is established, which shall consist of one dentist member of the board who has a permit to administer anesthesia, and 4 additional dentists currently licensed and permitted to administer anesthesia in a dental office appointed by the board.
  - (b) The committee shall elect a chair for a 3-year term. There shall be no term limits on committee membership.
  - II. The committee shall develop and propose the administrative rules regarding the practice, discipline, education, examination, and permitting of dentists and facilities authorized to administer anesthesia in a dental practice, for the board's consideration pursuant to RSA 317-A:12. The committee shall have no independent regulatory or disciplinary authority.
  - III. The rules proposed by the committee may be accepted by the board for adoption under RSA 317-A:12 and RSA 541-A or the board may decline to accept the committee recommendations if the board finds that the proposed rules exceed the jurisdiction or expand the scope of the committee beyond the authority granted in paragraph II, create an undue financial impact on board, or are not supported by the record.





# Summary of testimony presented:

Lisa Scott

- Ms. Scott testified that she came to discuss the changes thought through to SB 147 and the reasons behind those changes.
- Requested that a first change would be that one of the six members on the board of dental examiners have a permit for deep sedation and general anesthesia, that way the board will always have a member that has the expertise, regarding sedation, to advise the board on those matters. Also, to provide oversight on the

- Anesthesia and Sedation Committee, which is being requested through legislative changes.
- Requested an Anesthesia and Sedation Committee, as there formerly was such a committee until it was disbanded.
- Provided responsibilities, this committee would advise the board of dental examiners on sedation issues and would recommend rules and legislative changes regarding sedation. Ms. Scott continued saying this committee would also be suggesting the requirements that a licensee would need to satisfy to get a facility and individual permit for sedation. This committee would also create the simulated exams that would be used to examine the licensees by the inspectors to perform site inspections and comprehensive evaluations for sedation permits.
- Ms. Scott provided the committee with two permits. The first being the facility permit which would be appropriate for practices of multiple practitioners. Ms. Scott testified that this permit would prevent redundant inspections for a site that has already had a site inspection due to bringing on another provider. The second form was the facility hosting permit, which is relative to a dental office contracting with a sedation provider, such as an MD, anesthesiologist, a CRNA, or a dental anesthesiologist, the non-dental provider would not come under the board's jurisdiction. Ms. Scott continued that this permit would be able to track where providers are being used and to set requirements for the facility to make sure that sedation is being delivered in safety.
- Ms. Scott acknowledged that the board has already established the requirements to attain these permits and that these processes are being maintained.

# Linda Tatarcik.

- Ms. Tatarcik testified that her role as the public member on the board of dental examiners is to represent the public as an informed consumer and an advocate for well thought out rules in regard to keeping the public safe.
- Ms. Tatarcik stated that the intention of this bill is to make anesthesia safer and more available.
- Ms. Tatarcik urged the committee to pass SB 147.
