1           1 Department of Safety; Positions Abolished; Budget Reduction.

2           I. The following positions budged in accounting unit 02-23-23-234010-2913 (permits and  
3 licensing) are hereby abolished:

4                 (a) Program Assistant II

5                 (b) Program Assistant II

6                 (c) Supervisor I

7           II. In addition to any other required reductions, the department of safety is hereby directed  
8 to reduce state general fund appropriations in accounting unit 02-23-23-234010-2913 (permits and  
9 licensing) by \$401,650 for the biennium ending June 30, 2023.

10          2 Department of Safety; County Sheriffs Offices; Appropriation for Computer Hardware,  
11 Software, and Training. The sum of \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, is hereby  
12 appropriated to the department of safety for the purpose of distributing the sum of \$10,000 to each  
13 county sheriff's office for the purchase of hardware and software and to defray training costs  
14 required to comply with the provisions of RSA 159-D. The governor is authorized to draw a warrant  
15 for said sum out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

16          3 Contingency. If SB 141-FN of the 2021 general legislative session becomes law, or sections 3-9  
17 of HB 334 of the 2021 general legislative session becomes law, sections 1 and 2 of this act shall take  
18 effect July 1, 2021. If neither SB 141-FN nor HB 334 becomes law, sections 1 and 2 of this act shall  
19 not take effect.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

Add:

1. Abolishes certain positions in the department of safety, directs the department to make a budget reduction in the accounting unit relative to permits and licensing, and makes an additional appropriation to county sheriffs offices relative to criminal background checks, contingent on SB 141 or HB 334 of the 2021 general legislative session becoming law.
