Returning to the updated list of potential performance audit topics, the Committee discussed items No.12, Department of Revenue Administration - Collection of Overdue Taxes; No. 13, Public Utilities Commission - Electric Company Competition; and No. 14, Department of Administrative Services - Employee Self-Insurance Program.

On a motion by Representative Ober, seconded by Senator Barnes, that

the Legislative Budget Division, Audit Division prepare pre-scope statements reflecting the Committee's intentions for the three items discussed, and the order for the three audits be: Public Utilities Commission, Department of Revenue Administration, and Self-Insured Employee Health Benefits.
