<u>LRCP 24-001 Department of Transportation</u> – Stephen LaBonte, Administrator, Bureau of Right-of-Way, Department of Transportation presented the request and responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Senator D'Allesandro, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Transportation to sell 0.06 +/- of an acre of state-owned land within the right-of-way located on the northerly side of NH Route 27 (a/k/a Pleasant Street) in the Town of Epping, directly to Adam and Alexia Teixeria for \$10,500, which includes the \$1,100 Administrative Fee, subject to the conditions as specified in the request dated January 9, 2024.
