SUNDAY, JANUARY 1, 2017

The standard mileage rate for transportation expenses set by the Internal Revenue Service has been modified. The standard mileage rate effective January 1, 2017 will be 53.5 cents per mile. The federal mileage reimbursement rate for members of the General Court decreases from fifty-four (\$0.54) per mile to fifty-three and one half cents (\$0.535) per mile for all miles incurred on or after January 1, 2017. Mileage checks dated January 20, 2017 are for period 12/23/16 – 1/5/17 and will include both mileage rates. Please contact Legislative Accounting at 271-3162 with any questions about those payments.
