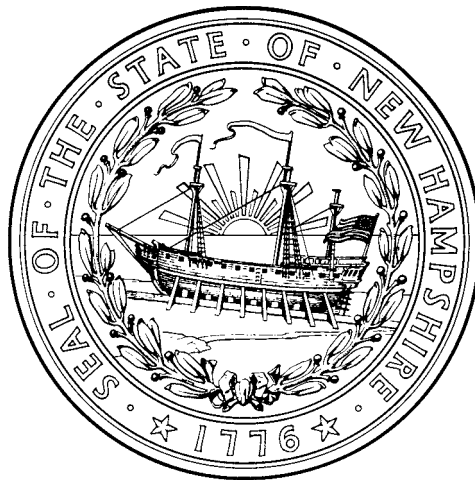

## INAUGURATION DAY

The Senate convened at 11:15 a.m., a quorum being present.

The Reverend Canon Hannah Anderson, guest chaplain to the Senate, offered the following meditation and prayer:

*O, gracious God, on this day of great anticipation, clear our minds and hearts to be fully present. You remind us that we find life and hope when we move from fear to freedom, from criticism to compassion, from self to servant-hood, from pretention to praise. To each Senator here today, O God, I pray for your blessing as your holy and living vessel: sturdy and true, never perfect, but able and willing to contain and pour out your purposes of freedom, justice and liberty for all. On this day of great anticipation, fill them with hope and gladness. Send them into the world as holy vessels and bearers of your image. Guide, watch over and protect them, their families and the people entrusted to them by election. In your holy name I pray* *Amen.*
