Statement by Sen. Bragdon on re-election as Senate President
Milford lawmaker given reigns for 2013-2014 on a unanimous vote

CONCORD – Sen. Peter Bragdon, R-Milford, issued the following statement today regarding his re-election as senate president on a unanimous vote:

“It’s an honor to be given the privilege of leading the state Senate for another two years and I thank my colleagues for putting their trust in me again. I look forward to working with my fellow senators on both sides of the aisle in balancing the budget, keeping taxes low and improving New Hampshire’s economy. Similar to the last two years, I expect the 2013-2014 session on the Senate side will be efficient, transparent and anchored by a no non-sense approach to conducting business for the taxpayers of New Hampshire.”

Background:

The Senate President’s previous tenure was defined by closing an \$800 million budget deficit, reforming the New Hampshire Retirement System, reducing intrusive audits on small businesses and establishing sensible Voter ID rules to help keep New Hampshire elections honest.

Bragdon’s top priorities for the upcoming session include: helping to create an environment conducive to job growth, targeting education aid to the students who need it most and building a state budget that is balanced and responsible, without new or increased taxes or fees.
