Bradley praises passage of spending transparency bill

Concord, NH – Senate Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro) today thanked his Senate colleagues for their unanimous support for his bill improving state agency budget reporting. SB 32, which received a 24-0 vote from the Senate, would require state departments to compile quarterly spending reports, including how their spending varies from projections and how much money they anticipate lapsing to the Treasury at the end of the Fiscal Year.

“This bill builds on the Transparent NH database we put in place under Governor Lynch, and would provide legislators and the general public with much better information on how state agencies are managing their budgets,” Bradley said. “Getting accurate and timely spending data out of state agencies has always been a challenge. This important bill would ensure that we’re not trying to build the next state budget in the dark.”
