### **Bradley praises NH House passage of bill eliminating license requirement to conceal firearms**

**Concord, NH** - The New Hampshire House of Representatives today passes a bill, SB 116, that would eliminate the license requirement to carry a concealed firearm.

The bill's prime sponsor, Senate Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro), released the following statement regarding its passage.

"I commend the House's support on this bill, SB 116, that restores our law-abiding citizens' rights to own and carry a firearm," said Senator Jeb Bradley (R- Wolfeboro).

"This modest bill merely allows somebody who has the right already to openly carry a weapon to do so on a concealed basis without securing a license. Vermont had long allowed this right to its citizens and is the safest state in the nation."

"I also support the House amendment that says individuals prohibited from possessing a firearm by New Hampshire or federal statute are also prohibited from carrying a concealed firearm."

"I hope the Governor will embrace this right of New Hampshire citizens to protect their lives, liberties, and loved ones," added Bradley.
