Senate passes bill to lower costs for NH public charter schools

Concord, NH – Today the Senate passed a bill, HB 662, which would allow a property tax exemption for properties rented by a public charter school.

“I commend my senate colleagues for passing this bill to allow local legislative bodies to create a tax exemption for public charter schools who pay property taxes through their lease agreements,” said Senator John Reagan (R- Deerfield).

“These schools are subject to a considerable financial hardship because of the current requirement and it is important that we create a level playing field for all of the state’s public education institutions.”
