**Senate supports bill clarifying domestic violence restraining orders**

**Concord, NH** – Today, the senate passed HB 648 which serves to clarify that individuals arrested for violating domestic violence restraining orders can only have bail set by a judge.

Senator Gary Daniels released the following statement on the bill's passage.

"With the passage of this bill, we reinforce the policy that those who violate domestic violence or stalking protective orders will be detained without bail pending their arraignment," said Senator Gary Daniels (R- Milford)

"This is one example of the Senate's commitment to public safety and I'm happy to have received the full senate's support on this legislation," Daniels added.
