Bradley supports transparency in new state agency budget reporting requirements

Concord, NH –Legislation was recently signed into law requiring state agencies which receive general funds provide quarterly budget reports to the Joint Legislative Fiscal Committee.

Senate Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro) who sponsored this legislation released the following statement on SB 32 becoming law.

“SB 32 will require agencies that receive appropriations from the state’s general fund to provide the Joint Legislative Fiscal Committee quarterly spending reports,” said Senate Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro).

“This legislation will provide the Joint Fiscal Committee with additional resources and increased transparency within agencies, but also allows the legislature to more clearly monitor statewide spending throughout the course of each budget cycle.”
