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Bradley statement on bill to reduce oral anti-cancer therapy costs

Concord, NH – HB 508 recently became law. This Legislation prohibits insurers from charging an insured a higher copayment, deductible, or coinsurance for anti-cancer medications, like self administered oral medications, than those same or different therapies administered in-office by a healthcare professional.

Senate Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro) who sponsored the chemotherapy legislation released a statement following the passage of this legislation into law.

“This common sense bill will prevent insurers from charging higher out-of-pocket costs for alternative or new chemotherapy treatments. This legislation is critical because it allows patients and doctors to choose the most effective option for their cancer treatment needs and therefore, are not limited by the form their treatment may take, whether it be orally or an in-office treatment or the cost that may be incurred.” said Senate Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro).
