**Birdsell applauds vote to maintain integrity of NH elections**

Concord, NH – The Senate today voted down a bill that would open the absentee ballot voting process to all voters in New Hampshire.

Senator Regina Birdsell (R-Hampstead), chair of Public and Municipal Affairs committee, issued the following statement on the vote.

“Today, the Senate protected and maintained the integrity of New Hampshire’s election process. Implementing an open absentee ballot process would have put undue hardship on our hard-working election officers who are tasked with ensuring that every vote cast in New Hampshire matters,” said Birdsell.
