**Reagan commends vote to allow Charter School students in public co-curricular activities**

Concord, NH - Today, the Senate voted to allow Charter School students to participate in local school district co-curricular activities.

Senator John Reagan (R-Deerfield, chair of the Education Committee issued the following statement upon the bill's passage.
