Birdsell praises bipartisan support for greater enforcement of NH voter laws

Concord, NH – The Senate approved a bill, SB 509, that would change the procedure for investigating new voters who do not confirm their status in New Hampshire.

Senator Regina Birdsell (R-Hampstead) issued the following statement.

“We appreciate the support from across the aisle on this bill which would streamline the process of verifying same day voter registrants in New Hampshire.”

“This bill allows the Secretary of state’s office to initiate the new voter registration verification process, freeing up capacity for the Attorney General’s office to investigate specific cases of voter fraud. This change increases protections for New Hampshire residents’ right to vote by strengthening the enforcement of voter laws in our state.”
