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Stiles stresses need to maintain medical services cost transparency for consumers

Concord, NH - The Senate today passed legislation, SB 431, which maintains cost transparency for medical services and ensuring that information continues to be readily available to New Hampshire consumers.

Senator Nancy Stiles (R-Hampton) issued the following statement on SB 431.

"This bill maintains the state's established policy of maximizing price information available to consumers by clarifying that the New Hampshire Insurance Department can continue collecting as much data as federal law permits."

"This legislation protects New Hampshire's consumer's ability to access cost information related to medical services, allowing them to view costs prior to accepting services and giving them the ability to choose services or providers based on price in an inclusive, easy to understand database."

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
