Avard urges equality before the law

Concord, NH -Today the Senate tabled a bill, SB 542, relative to the criminal interference with health services.

"The Senate does not condone violence against any facility, regardless of what services they provide and today's action by the Senate reinforces that commitment," said Senator Avard (R-Nashua).

"I firmly believe in receiving equal penalties for equal crimes. It should not matter whether you throw a brick through the window of a hardware store, a doctor's office, or a florist's shop. We have worked hard over the years to protect all New Hampshire citizens and to ensure uniform justice for all violators of the law. This bill would have done the opposite of that."
