## Morse focused on fixing retiree health program

*Bill would address long-term funding shortfall in current legislative session*

Concord, NH –The Senate Finance committee heard HB 1591 on Tuesday, which would address the shortfall for the state retiree’s health program.

“This piece of legislation will help ensure that there will be no gaps in retiree’s healthcare coverage,” said Senate President Chuck Morse (R-Salem)

“It would be incredibly irresponsible to expect the next legislature and governor to solve this problem which is why the Senate is committed to fixing this problem during this legislative session in order to minimize the impact on retirees. Doing nothing now and waiting until next year would just make the problem harder to fix and increase uncertainty for retirees.”
