Bill offers additional services for students with dyslexia

Concord, NH – Today, the Senate passed HB 1644, a measure to designate reading specialists to support students with dyslexia and other disorders.

Senator Kevin Avar (R-Nashua) issued a statement following the vote.

“We heard compelling testimony that there are students with dyslexia and other disorders often fall through the cracks in our schools and become self conscious of their inability to read at the same grade level as many of their peers. This legislation would provide additional educational resources and a reading specialist who would provide assistance tailored to students with dyslexia in order to help them overcome this roadblock to learning.”

“This is a small change that will have a dramatic effect for students with dyslexia and I praise the Senate’s strong support of this measure and look forward to this bill becoming law in New Hampshire.”
