Stiles not seeking re-election to NH Senate

Concord, NH - Senator Nancy Stiles (R-Hampton) issued the following statement.

"After 12 years of service between the House and the Senate, I've decided not to seek another term serving Senate District 24."

"While this is a bittersweet moment for me, I am proud of the work I've done throughout my career in public service. I have accomplished many of the goals I set out for in for my communities, focusing on education and health related issues specifically. I've fought all along in support of adequate education funding for students in New Hampshire. In the current budget, the state removes the cap on education adequacy funding for the next academic year, which I believe is one step toward supporting each student's opportunity for an excellent education."

"Constituent service has also been a critical part of my role in the legislature and it has always been a pleasure to serve the seacoast communities I call home. I am thankful both for all of the gracious support I have received over the years and for the many, lasting relationships I have made within the community I serve, both before and after re-districting."

"But there's been one constituent who has waited a long time for my full attention, and I am looking forward to spending more time with my husband, Howard, as well as our children and their families."
