Sanborn disappointed by vote maintaining restrictions on businesses

Concord, NH - Today, the Senate tabled a measure that would have allowed New Hampshire employers to pay employees on a weekly or biweekly basis, without prior permission from the Department of Labor.

Senator Andy Sanborn (R-Bedford) issued a statement following the action.

"I am disappointed that the Senate voted to continue punishing our business community by restricting their freedom to conduct their business at their discretion. The vote made today will require businesses to continue to needlessly spend time and money to beg permission of government as to when and how they pay their employees. By not allowing businesses owners to designate bi-weekly pay periods if they want, the state interferes with a business's ability to grow and expand in the state."
