**Carson urges local residents to attend DOT informational meeting on I-93 Exit 4A project**

Concord, NH – Senator Sharon Carson (R-Londonderry) issued the following statement on the upcoming public informational meeting between the Department of Transportation [DOT] and the general public on the I-93 Exit 4A interchange study.

“The September 27 public meeting will allow citizens in the surrounding communities the opportunity to learn more about the Exit 4A project while providing the opportunity to ask questions and discuss potential challenges that our towns may face,” said Senator Sharon Carson (R-Londonderry). “I am encouraged by DOT’s open and inclusive review and dialogue related to the construction of Exit 4A.
