Daniels concerned by burdensome small business regulation

Concord, NH - Senator Gary Daniels (R-Milford) issued a statement following the sustained veto of SB 446, relative to the state's building code requirements.

"Governor Hassan claims she is a supporter of small businesses, but preventing the passage of this legislation only serves to hurt our state's contractors by allowing for potential overreach of building inspectors, which this legislation sought to prevent," said Senator Gary Daniels (R-Milford).

"By sustaining the Governor's veto of this legislation, building inspectors can continue to request unreasonable information from contractors, potentially delaying projects and discouraging contractors from seeking new opportunities to do business in New Hampshire. Without this legislation, New Hampshire continues to allow for burdensome regulation, which is a disincentive to our state's small businesses, leading them to seek opportunities outside of our state."

"This legislation would have provided a small step forward to make New Hampshire a more business friendly state and I am concerned by the lack of support from my Democratic colleagues on this important issue."
