Avard disappointed by sustained veto of bill protecting NH landowners rights

Concord, NH –Today, the Senate failed to overturn the veto of SB 324, which would have limited the amount of land the federal government can acquire in the State of New Hampshire.

Senator Kevin Avard (R-Nashua) issued the following statement in response to the sustained veto.

“As a strong advocate for landowner rights, I continue to be displeased by the lack of support from the Governor and Senate democrats to strengthen landowner rights through legislation like SB 324, which would serve to strengthen protections and property rights of our citizens by limiting the amount of land the Federal Government can purchase in New Hampshire,” said Senator Kevin Avard (R-Nashua).

“Next session I plan to continue fighting to protect our citizen’s property by introducing new legislation that serves to prevent land loss by eminent domain and the Federal Government.”
