## **Bradley applauds Senate passage of concealed carry bill**

Concord, NH - Today, the Senate passed a bill to repeal the licensing requirement to carry a concealed firearm.

Senate Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro), the bill's prime sponsor, issued the following statement:

"Passing this legislation today is a common sense step to restore New Hampshire citizen's constitutional right to carry a concealed firearm without requiring a permit. This legislation serves to allow law-abiding individuals able to own a firearm to carry concealed and maintain their right to protect their lives, liberties and loved ones."

"We know that Maine and Vermont, two states that don't require a permit or license to carry a firearm, are among the safest in the nation with remarkably low gun violence rates."

"I look forward to this legislation passing through the House and Governor Sununu's support in allowing this bill to become law."
