Ward introduces bill to expand transparency for energy facility siting

Concord, NH -- Today, Senator Ruth Ward (R-Stoddard) issued the following statement after introducing a bill to expand the public notice requirements to include all surrounding municipalities, not just the community where the project is located, when siting an energy facility in New Hampshire.

"I firmly believe that all municipalities that may be impacted by energy facility siting, not just the town where the project exists, should receive deliberate notification throughout the process, providing greater transparency for all who may be affected."

"As New Hampshire works to find solutions to high energy costs that affect our business climate and homeowners alike, we need to ensure that any property owners who may be affected are part of conversation around the siting process and are provided the opportunity to weigh-in and ask questions about new energy projects across the state."

"I ask my senate colleagues for their support in providing greater transparency within the energy facility siting process."
