Bradley urges House to support eliminating concealed carry licensing in NH

Concord, NH – Today, the House Criminal Justice and Public Safety committee heard SB 12 which would eliminate the requirement to obtain a license to carry a concealed firearm in New Hampshire.

Senator Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro) issued the following statement:

“The evidence is clear that some of the safest states in the nation do not require law-abiding citizens, legally able to possess a firearm, to obtain a license to carry it on a concealed basis, including our neighbors Vermont and Maine. I have long said this is a common sense measure to restore our citizen’s constitutional right to protect their lives, liberties and loved ones and today I ask my fellow House legislators to support this bill.”
