Gannon urges support to increase Veteran's property tax credits

Concord, NH - Senator Bill Gannon (R-Sandown) issued the following statement on SB 168, which he sponsored, to allow towns the option of increasing the cap on the Veteran's property tax credit program.

"It is a pleasure to sponsor legislation that would allow cities and towns voluntarily increase the property tax credit given to Veterans on behalf of my constituents and veterans across our state," said Senator Bill Gannon (R-Sandown). "The popular veteran's tax credit program, which was capped at \$500 when it was established 12 years ago, has been adopted by many cities and towns across New Hampshire. This bill would give communities the opportunity to positively impact the lives of our veterans by allowing them to increase the capped property tax credit amount to \$1,000 should they so choose."

"The bill was overwhelming favored by New Hampshire Veteran's Group leaders as well as members of the public and I urge my Senate and House colleagues to support this measure."
