### **Daniels urges drug, alcohol funding to be discussed in budget process**

Concord, NH – Today, Senator Gary Daniels (R-Milford), Chair of the Senate Finance Committee, issued the following statement on a bill, SB 196, which would increase funds deposited in the Alcohol Abuse Prevention and Treatment Fund:

“We are all very concerned about drug and alcohol addiction in New Hampshire and ensuring that there are resources available for our citizens is certainly among our top priorities,” said Senator Gary Daniels (R-Milford). “As is part of the normal process, the legislation introduced today would best be considered in the budget process when we have a clearer understanding of our state’s financial picture as whole. In addition, I look forward to Governor Sununu’s leadership on drug and alcohol prevention, treatment and recovery efforts for the State of New Hampshire.”
