Senate moves forward with budget process

Finance committee set to begin work Monday

Concord, NH –Senate President Chuck Morse (R-Salem) issued the following statement after the House placed HB 1 and HB 2 on the table.

“I want to commend the House Finance Committee for their hard work on the Fiscal Year 2018-19 budget.”
