Gray praises support for CTE expansion in Rochester

Concord, NH - Today, the Senate Capital Budget Committee voted to fully fund the Career and Technical Education [CTE] renovation request for R.W. Creteau Regional Technology Center in Rochester, NH as part of the capital budget.

Senator James Gray (R-Rochester) issued the following statement:

"New Hampshire high tech manufacturing companies and businesses across our state are in need of a stronger skilled workforce to fill these good jobs.
