Birdsell commends passage of election integrity bill

Concord, NH - Today, the Senate concurred on SB 3, a bill clarifying the voter residency guidelines for New Hampshire elections. Senator Regina Birdsell (R-Hampstead) issued the following statement:

"I appreciate all of the hard work by both the House and the Senate on this very important legislation that will serve to strengthen and restore the integrity of our elections in New Hampshire. I am pleased the Senate voted to concur on this legislation today, sending it to Governor Sununu for his signature."

"This legislation simply asks New Hampshire residents to provide proof they live where they say they do when registering to vote in an election."

"This bill provides a delicate balance between making sure that every eligible voter has the opportunity to cast a ballot while protecting our elections from ineligible voters who knowingly choose to cast ballots in a New Hampshire election."
