Senate sends 'Croydon' bill to Governor

Concord, NH - Today, the Senate concurred with the House of Representatives on SB 8, which expands school choice for students residing in a town without its own public school.

Senator Ruth Ward (R-Stoddard), prime sponsor of this legislation, issued the following statement:

"I am pleased that the Senate concurred with the House's changes to SB 8 bringing us one step closer to allowing towns like Croydon, which does not have its own public school beyond fourth grade, to send students to the public or private school of their choosing in another community."
