### **Statement by Senate President Morse on U.S. Supreme Court decision regarding religious schools**

CONCORD, NH -- Senate President Chuck Morse (R-Salem) issued this statement following the U.S. Supreme Court's decision in *Carson v. Makin* that states may not exclude religious schools from programs benefitting other private schools:

"Today, the Court upheld the principle that private organizations may not be discriminated against because of their religious beliefs. We believe that parents know best on how their children should be educated. Whether they choose their local school district, a public charter school, a private school, or homeschooling, the State of New Hampshire is going to help them find the best education possible for every child."
