Senate Democrats Stand with the National Democratic Party instead of the NH Primary

Concord, NH – Senator Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro) released the following statement on the defeat of Senate Bill 271:

“Senate Republicans stood up to ensure that everyone casting a ballot in the New Hampshire primary has his or her vote counted, and not watered down because of national party rules. Senate Democrats inexplicitly abandoned their primary voters to support their national party’s interests,” stated Senator Bradley.

“Since 1916, New Hampshire has chosen its delegates to the Republican and Democratic National Conventions through our historic primary. Granite Staters have always done an exemplary job in vetting candidates and strengthening campaigns level by asking the hard questions.
