Bill Analysis: This bill establishes salary grades for the following unclassified positions: assistant state veterinarian, tax policy analyst, insurance fraud investigator, and director of fire standards, training and emergency medical services.

Summary of testimony presented in support:

Senator Reagan said he was the Chairman of the Joint Committee on Employee Classification (JCEC).

- When a job is reclassified, these jobs are in statute so it requires the JCEC to change the statute for proper information, i.e., pay grades of respective positions.
- This legislation is housekeeping for work which was completed last year.
- The legislation required five positions to change in statute.
