ANALYSIS

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Section; Humane Society Directional Signs. Amend RSA 228 by inserting after section
2 38 the following new section:

3 228:38-a Humane Society Directional Signs. The commissioner may erect on any class I or
4 class II highway reflective directional signs designating the route or exit to the nearest animal
5 shelter. Such signs shall be erected in those locations as the commissioner, after consultation with
6 the local humane society, may determine to be in the best public interest. The cost for the signs and
7 erection of such signs shall be borne by the local humane society.

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
