The Public Utilities Commission states this bill will increase the current Chairman's salary to \$128,260 from \$121,488 and benefits to \$25,844 from \$24,480. This change will increase State restricted expenditures by \$8,136 $((\$128,260 - \$121,488) + (\$25,844 - \$24,480) = \$8,136)$ annually.
