Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Youth Access to and Use of Tobacco; Tobacco Use Prevention and Cessation Program. Amend
2 RSA 126-K:15 to read as follows:

3 126-K:15 Tobacco Use Prevention and Cessation Program.

4 ***I.*** There is hereby established in the department of health and human services the tobacco
5 use prevention and cessation program, which shall be administered with funds appropriated to the
6 department for such purpose, and which shall include but not be limited to:

7 ~~[I.]~~ ***(a)*** Tobacco use prevention community programs and grants.

8 ~~[II.]~~ ***(b)*** Tobacco use prevention school programs and grants.

9 ~~[III.]~~ ***(c)*** Tobacco use prevention state-wide programs and grants.

10 ~~[IV.]~~ ***(d)*** Tobacco use cessation programs.

11 ~~[V.]~~ ***(e)*** Tobacco use prevention and cessation counter marketing.

12 ~~[VI.]~~ ***(f)*** Evaluation of tobacco control initiatives.

13 ~~[VII.]~~ ***(g)*** Administration and enforcement.

14 ***II. In this section, "tobacco" includes e-cigarettes and liquid nicotine as those***
15 ***terms are defined in RSA 126-K:2.***

16 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
