This bill modifies the requirements for licensure of magnetic resonance technologists by the board of medical imaging and radiation therapy.

AN ACT relative to the licensure of medical imaging professionals.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Magnetic Resonance Technologists; Licensure. Amend RSA 328-J:11, II(d) and (e) to read as
2 follows:

3 (d) Possess current certification and registration in radiography from the American
4 Registry of Radiologic Technologists or current certification and registration in magnetic resonance
5 from the [~~American Registry of Radiologic Technologists~~] ***American Registry of Magnetic***
6 ***Resonance Imaging Technologists*** or a certification organization approved by the board.

7 (e) By January 1, 2020, all applicants for a magnetic resonance technologist license
8 shall be certified in magnetic resonance by the [~~American Registry of Radiologic Technologists~~]
9 ***American Registry of Magnetic Resonance Imaging Technologists*** or a certification
10 organization recognized by the board.

11 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
